CROWN DINING

Traditional timber framed joinery in post and beam construction is not truly appreciated. We assume the massive posts and beams above our heads are connected adequately, but in reality we prefer to marvel at the beauty and scale of the timbers themselves.

The Crown table celebrates the traditional art of joinery by connecting three timbers of equal length in perfect symmetry. To highlight the union of the timber, we provide a 1/4 scale model of the actual sized crown base that can be disassembled to show the beautiful joinery of the full scaled piece.

*Shown with base in Douglas-fir with soft white hardwax oil finish; 1/2" (12mm) starphire glass top

The three timber elements are nestled by gravity and secured by a heavy table top. The base can accomodate 60" diameter and 72" diameter tops
