



SEA GLASS TABLE

The Seaglass Bench is inspired by the Pacific Northwest, shaped like a half shell of the bi-valve clams that litter the sandy shores. Along the shore, the shells are mixed with bits of seaglass, whose once sharp edges have been smoothed by the sea. The coast habitat serves as a reminder of the tenacity and generosity of Mother Nature.

When my children were small we would walk along the beaches in Tofino and collect pockets full of this sea glass, pebbles and shells. The worn textures of a once shiny and sharp surface now were safe and pleasing to hold. The coastal habitat serves as a reminder of the tenacity and generosity of our Mother Nature. The Seaglass Bench represents renewal, and encourages a moment of appreciation for the processes that shape, and re-shape, our environment.
